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- **Remote engagement, land manoeuvre and air mobility:** Robotics, drones, tactical mobility and other innovative effectors embody the modernisation of capabilities and diversification of force engagement methods.
- **Comprehensive security, risk prevention and crisis management:** In the face of multiple crises, surveillance, coordination and population protection technologies are growing in importance.
- **Industrial resilience and war economy:** industrial sovereignty and the ability to manufacture quickly and over the long term are becoming the pillars of the defense of the future.

These themes, at the heart of the live content programme and the exhibition zones, will offer foresight on the major contemporary issues in security and defense.

Spearheaded by its teams, Coges Events is continuing to drive the exhibition's shift towards a more sustainable and meaningful model.
